Day 1Nov 13**

Honolulu → Incheon

Our vacation starts by boarding an international flight bound for Seoul, the capital of South Korea. Meals and snacks will be served on the plane.

Day 2Nov 14**

Incheon

We arrive at Incheon International Airport where an Air and Sea Travel representative will greet us and transfer us to our hotel.

Day 3Nov 15** **Incheon – Mt. Seoraksan** **(B, L, D)**

This morning, we transfer to **Mt. Seoraksan**, which offers breathtaking views and is the home of 2,000 animal species and more than 1,400 rare plant species. UNESCO Historical Site designated this national park a Biosphere Preservation District in 1982 and the park has become the most famous national park in Korea. After that, we will take a **cable car** to go up to **Gwongseumseong Castle** and enjoy a panoramic view of the mountain. Then, we visit the **Sinhungsa temple**, on the path to Sinheungsa, there is a great bronze statue called the Great bronze statue, which is well over 10 meters high. Just beyond the statue, which is on a granite terrace, there is a bridge to the right called Hyeonsugyo, which was newly built for crossing the ravine. The buildings which were built during that time are still standing, like the sanctuary, main temple, Myeongbujeon, Bojaeru, Chilseonggak, etc. There is also an important cultural property, Treasure No. 443, called Hyangseongsaji, a three-story stone tower. We visit **Fishery village “Abai Village”**, a famous film shooting place for Korean Drama. We take a ‘Gaetbae’ boat that operates on manpower (people pulling on ropes moving the boat across a waterway) Then, we visit Daepohang Port, This bustling port has become one of the most popular tourist spots for those in search of the freshest raw fish restaurants.

Day 4Nov 16** **Mt. Seoraksan – Suwon – Seoul** **(B, L, D)**

After breakfast, we will return to Seoul. One the way, we will visit a **Fruit Farm** to experience **fruit picking**. Then, we transfer to **Korean Folk Village** located in Yongin city. Visitors can see how people lived in the Joseon era. Thanks to the reproduced farmhouse, commoner’s house, government office, school, marketplace, and noble’s house (Yangban), the village is a good place to start and see the history of Korea. After lunch, we will return to Seoul, and we will proceed to **Dongdaemun Market**, a large commercial district with traditional markets and shopping centers. It is a popular shopping and tourist destination that has been designated a 'Special Tourism Zone' since 2002. Check-in to our hotel after dinner.

Day 5Nov 17** **Seoul** **(B, L, D)**

Today, we will have a City Tour in Seoul, discovering the new era at hand in Korea, what the world calls New Seoul. First, we will head to the beautiful **Gyeongbokgung Palace** to experience the most representative edifices of the Joseon Dynasty (more than 500 years old) and visit the **National Folk Museum** to see Korean Unique culture as well as people’s lifestyle in the olden days. We also enjoy the **Traditional Royal Guard Changing Ceremony**. Then, we will be passing by the **Presidential Blue House**. After a Korean food feast for lunch, we will breathe in the history with a walk around the **Bukchon Hanok Village** seeing several traditional homes, Hanok. We join the **DIY Kimchi-making class** and take photos in the **Korean Traditional outfit Hanbok**. Lastly, we visit **Gwangjang Market**. Gwangjang Market was the first permanent market in Korea and continues to thrive as a popular tourist destination today. The second floor of the market is filled with silk, satin, and linen bed-sheet stores, which are the largest and most famous in Seoul.

Day 6Nov 18** **Seoul** **(B)**

Today, you can enjoy leisure time on your own.

Optional tour: Tour to the Demilitarized Zone (DMZ)

The boundary that divides North and South Korea. The armistice that put a halt to the Korean War (1950-1953) divided the Korean Peninsula into South and North Korea. The two sides are separated by the Korean Demilitarized Zone, or DMZ, running along the 38th parallel north.

Day 7Nov.19** **Seoul – Incheon → Honolulu** **(B)**

After breakfast, we enjoy the last minute shopping at **Myeongdong**, a huge pedestrian marketplace with lots of shopping in the heart of Seoul. Afterwards, we head to **Namdaemun Local Market**, the largest and oldest wholesale market in Korea, where we can find practically everything here at affordable prices. We can enjoy our own food - fusion, International, and street food. In the evening, we will transfer to the airport for our return flight home ending our fantastic journey in Korea.

10. All guests travelling on this Journey are required to be fully COVID vaccinated at least 2 weeks prior to departure. Vaccines combined with multi-layered preventative health and safety measures will help us provide a safe and healthy vacation environment. Each guest must acknowledge vaccination status at the latest 7-days prior to departure and email proof of vaccination to Air & Sea Travel Center. Guests who are not old enough to be vaccinated or otherwise not eligible to be vaccinated will not be allowed on this trip. All tour participants will be required to be fully vaccinated even if they have antibodies from prior infections, regardless of the guest’s citizenship and their local government’s regulations.
11. Guests will be required to wear masks indoors when social distancing is not possible (e.g. on the tour bus). Furthermore, local government regulations may require all guests to wear masks while indoors except for when actively eating or drinking or when in their hotel room. Face masks that have two or more layers that completely cover your nose and mouth and fit snugly on your face are permitted. Face masks should block light when held up to bright light source. Masks with exhalation valves or vents; single layer or masks made of thin fabric that don’t block light (i.e. neck gaiters) are not permitted.
12. As government regulations evolve, our health and safety protocols will evolve as needed to ensure compliance. This may mean different protocols from state to state and city to city based on local requirements.

Payment Policy:

CHECK OR CASH PAYMENT ONLY. A deposit of \$ 350 per person is required at the time of application. The balance of payment is due on **Sep.1, 2022**. In case balance of payment is not made within the required time period, Air and Sea Travel Center reserves the right to cancel reservations and charge a cancellation fee.

Cancellation Policy:

Written notice is required for any cancellation. After **Sep.1, 2022**, the cancellation fee will be as follow:
** **Sep.2 – Oct.1, 2022, 50%** of total price plus any other service fee caused from the cancellation;
** **From Oct.2, 2022 to the departure** or withdrawing during the tour shall be regarded as willingly giving up all rights concerned, **100%** of total price, and request for other services as a substitute shall not be accepted.
